Charity Report- Project Graduation

Almost 33 years ago Jupiter High School graduated 60 seniors. On graduation night 3 of these graduates were killed in an alcohol induced automobile accident when they tried to perform a "Burt Reynolds - Smokey and the Bandit" jump across the old Indiantown Road bridge over the intercostal waterway. 5% of the graduating class had been lost on graduation night.

The current Worshipful Master at that time, Ray Kinser, of Jupiter Light Lodge F&AM #340, decided that something had to be done to prevent this from happening again. He found that some Mason Lodges in the Northeast had hosted an all-night supervised non-alcohol/drug party where no one was permitted to leave without being picked up by their parents until morning. He proposed doing the same thing here in Jupiter to the officers of the lodge and received their full support. The following year "Jupiter High School Project Graduation" was born.

The members of the Lodge solicited local businesses and residents for donations and held the first "Chicken Dinner" to raise money to host a fun party with great prizes and plenty of fun things to do. The first party was held in the Lodge. This continued for several years until the graduating class became too big for the Lodge and was moved to the Jupiter High School gym. The Lodge continued with the Chicken Dinners and it has been the largest fund raiser for this event to this day.

The most important thing about Project Graduation is that since it began, no graduating senior has lost his/her life on graduation night. This program has worked just as envisioned by the Brothers of the Lodge 33 years ago.
