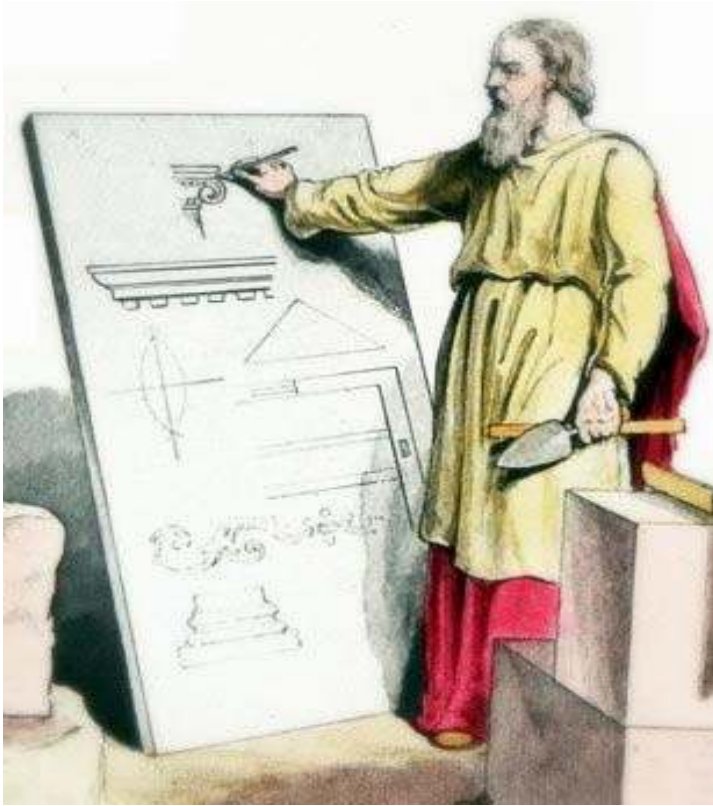

Charity Report

Brethren,

What a wonderful year we are having at Jupiter Light! In May we raised \$350 for the Safety Council of Palm Beach County, bringing our total as of that date to \$3,700. In June we collected money for the Best Friends Club and had the fishing tournament to benefit the Quantum House. Rumor has it that the tournament netted more than in years past; details will follow in the August report.

Our charity for July will be the Masonic Medical Research Laboratory. Founded in 1958 by the Grand Lodge of NY, its scientists have played and continue to play a pivotal role in defining the majority of mechanisms responsible for abnormal rhythms of the heart, thereby contributing to implementation of the pacemaker, implantable cardioverter defibrillator, catheter ablation therapy and a wide variety of drugs used to treat heart disease. They uncovered the first gene responsible for sudden death in young adults and provided the first direct evidence linking an abnormal heart rhythm, to a form of Sudden Infant Death (SIDS). The MMRL is the leading center for study of the heart in the United States.
