Message from the WEST -

BLACKWATER-GATE UPDATE

As the Master and Junior Warden correctly discuss the Lodge calendar and fun events each month, your SW has been mired in the sloshing bucket, lavatory leviathan, a.k.a. Blackwater-Gate.



In that context, I'd like to introduce you to the "Kick the 'Can' to the Curb Campaign" to drive out broken septic tanks. As many of you know, we had a vendor drive his truck into our septic tank last October. The truck crushed the lid and cracked the walls of the septic tank rendering it un-repairable. To add insult to injury, the appropriate governmental authority will not allow us to replace the tank, but rather demands that we connect to city sewer.

Some of you may believe this is simply matter of "laying some pipe". Such I assure you is not the case. Without attempting to explain the comprehensive plan and scope of work in detail here, and by way of but a few examples, we are required to install a "grease trap" for our kitchen, to connect at 3 places to the building, cut the sidewalk and street, and bore into a man hole. This is an expensive proposition.

Since the mishap, we have timely filed insurance claims, prepared a site plan, bid out the project, received 4 bids and made a 30 day demand for payment to the vendor's insurance carrier (all at no expense to the Lodge, thank you brothers Anderson and Barlow!). As expected, however, the insurance claims process has been a slogging "clog the pipes" endeavor, so to speak.

Currently we have the funds to complete the connection work but the expense would leave us almost nothing in reserve. Additionally, without an operating waste removal system, we risk losing our new tenant, which would further impact our "bottom" line.

At this point there is a real possibility we may have to, at least initially, pay out of pocket to begin the necessary work. We can't simply stand by and leave a hole of "blackwater yuk" open for the unsuspecting to fall into while we wait on the insurance company to do the right thing. Further, there's a chance the tank will stop working, which would bring activities at lodge to a quick and malodorous halt.

If the insurance company doesn't timely respond to our demand letter then we may have to retain the services of an insurance litigation firm to pursue the vendor (carrier). The firm would most likely take the case on a contingency basis, meaning there would be NO cost to Lodge unless recovery is made. However, the case could take a LONG time to resolve.

So, I appeal to the brothers of Jupiter Light and the members of all our appendant bodies who appreciate and acknowledge the benefits of a "flush and forget" toileting policy: PLEASE GIVE GENEROUSLY TO THE KICK THE CAN TO THE CURB CAMPAING TO DRIVE OUT BROKEN SEPTIC TANKS. See the Lodge Secretary or Treasurer to "dump" your deposit or you may make donations at any meeting by dumping in the BOX OF SEPTIC SALVATION (thank you Brother Jason Silvers for the coin phrase!).




