The Degree was well attended and I would personally like to congratulate these Brothers on their accomplishment. We look forward to seeing much more of you!

The Grand Master will visit the District on Saturday, Sept. 8th at the Lake Worth Scottish Rite. Please come out and show your support for the Lodge and your Grand Master. We have some great presentations for Most Worshipful George Aladro and your dinner is already paid for!

We will have a dinner at the Lodge on Sept. 22nd at 6:00 p.m. and we'll also reinstate Movie Night on Friday the 28th at 7:00 p.m. Please join us and bring the family and friends and enjoy the fellowship!

Unfortunately, due to circumstances out of our control, our lease was terminated with the Church of God last month. The issue was scheduling and having access to the lodge when needed so the craft voted to end the relationship. This was an understandable decision. However, this was a great source of revenue for our lodge and will be sorely missed. As we have approx. \$80,000 to \$100,000 worth of improvements needed to our Lodge in the next 5 to 7 years, it is imperative that we replace the lost revenue. As our monthly schedules are quite busy already and it will be difficult to add more fundraisers, one way to do this is by increasing our Annual Dues. I feel this is a necessary evil as we have not raised dues in over 6 years and the cost of running the lodge goes up every year. Today, we pay \$85.00/yr. This is very low in comparison to other Lodges and significantly behind the cost of living.

There will be discussions as to how much the increase should be in the near future. Stay tuned!
