## Payment of Wages from the West!

The Mosaic Pavement

This is commonly described as the checkered tile which covers the

floor of the lodge under the Bible, Square and Compasses. The Mosaic Pavement is first mentioned in the lecture for the Entered Apprentice degree. The lecture says that the mosaic pavement "is a representation of the ground floor of King Solomon's Temple" and is "emblematic of human life, checkered with good and evil."

In the account of King Solomon's Temple in the Bible, the ground floor is said to be made of pine or fir, depending on which translation of the Bible you read (1 Kings 6:15). It is hard to imagine that pine or fir flooring would be particularly mosaic in nature. However, it can be agreed that the mosaic pavement represents the ground floor of King Solomon's Temple in the Entered Apprentice degree because that ceremony symbolically takes place in that location.

While these facts may not be particularly intriguing, the symbolism of the checkered flooring presents some interesting Masonic concepts. The idea of duality and the conflict between good and evil are certainly cause for contemplation and may provide a symbolic balance, thereby providing the foundation for Masonic growth. Maintaining balance allows us to adhere to many Masonic teachings. By maintaining balance, we are able to stand upright in our several stations before
